Dynanet FDA Team Wins New Task Order October 2015

Edaptive Systems has awarded Dynanet nearly \$4M in new task orders to continue its work at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). That work includes full life cycle support of three systems for the Center for Devices and Radiological Health (CDRH): a business intelligence/data warehouse system and two custom Java-based, intranet systems. For the last four years, Dynanet has partnered with Edaptive Systems to maintain and enhance those systems as part of Edaptive's CDRH Center Submission Tracking And Reporting (CSTAR) contract. CSTAR systems



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help CDRH protect and promote the public health by ensuring that patients and providers have timely and continued access to safe, effective, and high-quality medical devices and safe radiation-emitting products. Dynanet follows the Scrum and Kanban agile techniques to enhance the systems with new releases every few months.

The new task orders cover Dynanet’s ongoing work to replace 250 Oracle forms and several non-integrated databases with a custom Java application and a relational, integrated database. Dynanet will continue automating the operation of CDRH’s document control center, which receives the data that CDRH needs to perform its premarket reviews and approvals of medical products.

The new task orders also include a pilot allowing medical device manufacturers to submit product information electronically. Dynanet’s support of the pilot will include designing and developing a web services Application Programming Interface (API) to supplement the system that members of the CDRH document control center use to manually enter the medical device product information into a shared transactional database. The new web services will let manufacturers submit the same information electronically through a web portal. Manufacturers can also use the new web services to check the review status of their products without having to call FDA staff.

Dynanet Successfully Appraised at CMMI Level 3

Dynanet is excited to announce that we have achieved CMMI Level 3 Maturity. This has been a long journey of process improvement across our software engineering practices and is a testament to our employee’s commitment to the quality of our work products. Although achieving maturity is a milestone, these audits are about finding process improvement opportunities to even better our service to our customers. The audited projects were selected from our FDA CDRH practice. An interesting point of consideration is that CMMI is mostly a “Waterfall” centric framework and Dynanet achieved our maturity rating in an Agile SCRUM practice. Special thanks to Mike McEwen and his team of professionals in leading the way to CMMI Level 3. We look forward to continuing the journey to even higher levels of quality to and for our customers.
